“All flesh is like grass  
and all its glory like the flower of grass.  
The grass withers,  
and the flower falls,  
but the word of the Lord remains forever.”

And this word is the good news that was preached to you. 1 Peter 1:24–25

We will see a similar statement in this weekend's Gospel. Jesus says that heaven and earth will pass away but His words will not pass away. God's word and God's promise is eternal. Everything that we can see is transitory. What is unseen is eternal. St. Paul tells us that in the Second Letter to the Corinthians. If God's word is eternal, we can trust it. But sometimes we prefer to trust in the physical, what we can see or touch. Just because we cannot see a hidden reality does not make it unreal. In fact, those things are more real than transitory things.
